As you are aware, ICDS, a centrally sponsored Scheme, is being implemented through the State Governments/UT Administrations. The performance and implementation of the ICDS is uneven across States/UTs which has evolved with differential approaches across the States/UTs.

- 2. In such a diverse and widespread programme use of ICT becomes inevitable in monitoring outreach, communication, education and management, etc. Information and Communication Technology has varied applications for which there is enough potential under the ICDS to use it beyond monitoring purposes. There are many examples of innovative and successful interventions by the State Governments/UTs and other partners/agencies that have shown encouraging results and have potentials of being customized and upscaled.
- 3. In order to share the existing knowledge, mechanisms and experiences in the field of ICT, this Ministry is organizing a two days Workshop on use of ICT in ICDS at Conference Hall, NIPCCD, Hauz Khas, New Delhi on 31st May, 2012 and 1st June, 2012. First day is proposed to be largely devoted on enlisting/presenting ICT related activities and the second day would be devoted on working out the way-forward. The consultation would serve as a platform for bringing together the State Governments/UTs and development partners for generating discussions and delving upon appropriate solutions for strengthening the use of ICT in ICDS.

5. You are accordingly invited to participate in the above two days Workshop alongwith your core team (maximum two persons) relating to the issue. We would appreciate sharing experiences in the use of ICT in ICDS in your State. AGENDA

1. Background

The proposed strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme provides for increased focus on effective use of Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) under ICDS. The focus will be on strengthening the information base and facilitating sharing and dissemination of information. Besides, the proposed strengthening and restructuring also focuses on strengthening the current Management Information System (MIS) and setting up a National Nutrition Surveillance System under ICDS. The revised monitoring system would focus on collecting & providing data on a real time basis to support the programmatic actions and timely interventions.

Over the years, ICDS has evolved with differential approaches across the States and there are many examples of innovative and successful models implemented by the State Governments that have shown good results and have potentials of being up-scaled. There are various specific examples of innovative models of ICT developed and implemented by State Governments, local bodies and development partners dealing with specific components of the ICDS Scheme that can be further explored for up-scaling and replication.

In order to share the existing knowledge and understand the state level priorities, implementation mechanisms and experiences of the above, the Ministry of Women and Child Development proposes to organize a two days Consultationon ICT in Delhi. The consultation would serve as a platform for bringing together the State Governments, local bodies and development partners for generating discussions and delving upon appropriate solutions for strengthening the use of ICT in ICDS.

2. Objectives

- (i) To discuss the proposed vision and plan of action on the use of ICT under the ICDS strengthening and restructuring;
- (ii) To discuss the existing innovative models / practices in use of ICT developed and implemented by various State Governments, local bodies and development partners;
- (iii) To discuss and identify strategies and plan of action for strengthening the use of ICT under ICDS;
